Applications open on Tuesday 31 March 2026

- Deadline: Monday 25 May 2026 at 5pm
- Submit your application before this date



Who Can Apply?



You can apply if:

- You are an artist, animator, or group
- You are Black or global majority
- You are based in England
- You are not a full-time student



You cannot apply if:

- You are a full-time student

Global majority means people of

- African
- Asian
- Indigenous
- Latin American
- or mixed-heritage backgrounds.

Step-by-Step Guide to Your Application

Your Details

What to write:

- Full Name
- Email Address
- Address
- Postcode
- Phone number

Example:

Name Joe Bloggs

Email joebloggs@example.com

Address 123 High Street, London

Postcode E1 6AN

Phone 07123 456 789

2 About You

What to write:

Tell us about yourself (in a 2-minute video/audio or up to 300 words).

What to include:

- Your approach to animation
- Materials you use
- Themes or concepts you like
- How long you have been making animations
- Artists or films you admire
- Any experience (screenings, exhibitions, jobs)

Example:

"I love making animations using [style]. I have been animating for [time] and my work has been shown at [examples]. I am inspired by [animator/artist]."

3 Your Animation Idea

What to write:

Describe your 3-minute animation idea (in a 2-minute video/audio or up to 300 words).

What to include:

- The concept (main idea)
- Techniques you will use (e.g., stop-motion, 2D, CGI)
- Equipment/software you will use
- What it will look like
- Will it have a story?
- What will the sound be like?

Example:

"My animation is about [themes/ideas]. I will use [technique]. The story/look is [description]. The sound will be [description]."

Examples of Your Work

What to do:

Upload no more than two of your best animations.

How to share:

1. Upload your full video to Vimeo or YouTube.
2. Send us the link to your video.
3. If the video is private, provide the password.

Remember:

- Keep videos online until June 2026.
- You can also send a PDF with pictures (no more than 10 pages).

Example:

"Title: [Animation Title]

Description: [What is the film about? How did you make it?]

Hard Words Explained

Word	Meaning
Application	A form you fill in to ask for something.
Animation	Moving pictures, like cartoons.
Concept	The main idea of your film.
Techniques	The way you make your animation.
PDF	A file you can read on a computer.
Global majority	People of African, Asian, indigenous, Latin American, or mixed-heritage backgrounds.

Checklist Before You Send Your Application

- I filled in all my details.
- I told you about myself (in 2 minutes or 300 words).
- I described my animation idea (in 2 minutes or 300 words).
- I shared links to my previous films.
- I agreed to the declaration.
- I submitted my application online or in another format.
